

GUIDELINES FOR PRIVATE ZONE/OPEN ZONE PROCESS

1. Members must pay full dues to be eligible to participate in the Private Zone Plan.
2. The Selection meeting will be held at noon on the last Saturday of General Gun Season in the first year of implementation. Thereafter, Selection will be handled at the Annual Meeting.
3. The selection order will be by the year members enter Cuba Bay Hunt Club.
4. Only one (1) Private Zone may be selected.
5. Only one (1) Open Zone may be flagged.
6. Members may not establish more than two (2) stands in Open Zones, which must be labeled with the membership name. Accessible stands on Club food plots are not included in this number.
7. There is no expectation of ownership of any form in an Open Zone.
8. Senior members or any membership not wishing to participate in the Private Zone Program may flag Open Zones only.
9. Each Annual Meeting, zones will be made available on the Open Market by members dropping out or when zones are "Turned In". The process described in #3 will be conducted on Open Zones for trade and/or made available to new members.
10. Private Zones will be effective from September 1st to the last day of General Gun Season. Once any deer season begins, no one should enter the interior of a Private Zone other than the membership of the Private Zone or those the membership approves. Board Members may enter Private Zones to conduct Club business at any time once it is determined that no one is hunting at the time.
11. Members will be responsible for all road and food plot trimming within their zone and roads bordering the zone. Two (2) or more zones bordering the same road will share in the task.
12. The Club will still be responsible for planting established Club food plots in all zones.
